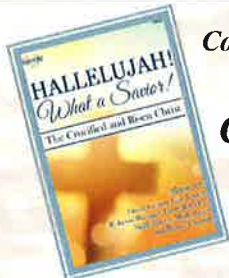

Happy Anniversary to Hillsdale... 56 Years "Young" Today!

Good morning and welcome to Hillsdale Baptist Church! Beginning in the fall of 1961, members of Buffalo Avenue Baptist Church had a vision for a church plant in what was northwest Tampa at that time... Hillsborough Avenue and Dale Mabry (hence the name, "Hillsdale"). Buffalo Avenue Baptist Church (no longer in existence due to the expansion of what is currently Interstate 275), was a historic, Independent Baptist church; however, it was landlocked and was experiencing, by the early 1960's, a movement of its membership to what we know today as subdivisions.

As with any change, the mother church and the infant church, faced great challenges, internally and externally. In early 1962, the new church began meeting in a theatre that had been a part of Drew Field in World War II (i.e. "Drew Army Air Force Base") and is today the site of Tampa International Airport. On May 9, 1962, the members of Hillsdale voted to purchase property from the owner of a chicken farm, purchasing 3.5 acres at the corner of Church Avenue and Henry Avenue for \$18,000. Over the years, several pieces of adjoining property were purchased and buildings were erected as God blessed.

I am privileged to be the fourth pastor in Hillsdale's history. Pastor Harold Bowe was the pastor of Buffalo Baptist Church before assuming the pastorate of Hillsdale Baptist Church as its founding pastor. Missionary to Liberia, Rev. Robert Smith, assumed the pastorate of Hillsdale in 1964, as the church moved from the theatre in Drew Park into its new building. Pastor Smith announced his intent to become an evangelist in 1965, and resigned as pastor Aug. 29, 1965.

After forming a pulpit committee, the church considered several candidates, but finally settled on the man who would pastor the church for nearly 30 years, Dr. Alan Bradshaw. Pastor Bradshaw was officially called to be Hillsdale's third pastor, October 20, 1965. He and his wife LuAnn, two daughters, Teresa and Laura, arrived in Tampa late November 1965, (Susan, the Bradshaw's third daughter was born December 1966). Pastor Bradshaw preached his first Sunday messages November 28, 1965, and faithfully served the LORD until his sudden home-going, June 21, 1995.

After serving as interim pastor, I was given the trust of this body of believers, becoming the fourth pastor of Hillsdale, Sunday, October 1, 1995. The majority of Hillsdale's charter members are with the LORD; however, there are a few who have been blessed to be a part of her many transitions. On your behalf, I want to express our debt of gratitude to the three remaining charter members: Mrs. Evelyn Ryan, Mrs. Penni Linderman Jividen, and Mr. Mark Keller.

Praise the LORD; Great is His Faithfulness!
