Memorial Day Picnic

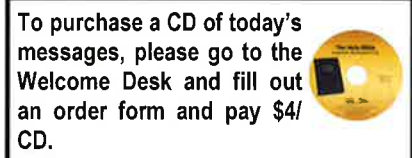
